

## **Arrival and General Information for AFS Hungary Summer Homestay Program**

June 28-July 12, 2008

The participants are arriving June 28th in the afternoon. After arriving in Hungary they are going to the handicraft camp with the help of our volunteers. (A bus will take them from the airport to the campsite.) The camp is in Jászárokszállás, a small town about 2-hour-drive from Budapest, at the foot of Matra hill in the northeastern part of Hungary.

The camp is a big farm like place where accommodation is in small 2-3 bedroom houses that are equipped with bathroom and toilet. Bedrooms vary in size from 2-6 beds. Room for most of the activities is available on spot, but the students will visit local farms, and will take trips to nearby hills, forests and bigger cities.

The participants are mainly girls. Staff consists of volunteers of AFS Hungary and, of course, teachers who will coordinate special craft activities.

On July 12th in the morning students will meet with their host families. After a short orientation they will leave with the host families and will spend the next 3 weeks with them.

On August 2nd we gather again in Budapest.

The students will take part in a pre-departure orientation and will have the opportunity to see a little more of Budapest. Volunteers will guide them around the city and organize fun programs for them. On August 3rd we will take them to the airport and bid farewell to them.
